LESSON PLAN FOR RESPECT

Purpose: To understand Respect, and the other words that accompany this important word.

Procedures:

1. Review what Respect means, recalling what was talked about during the Respect Program learn or review the word list below:

- 2. Have each student look up each word and then write a sentence and have them relate it to Respect.
- 3. Using the grid included, have each student create their own Bingo board using these words. Each word can only be used once when they create their board. (Exact Bonus: Have one class create these boards and then have them laminated for future games, if not please recycle all paper that has been used.)
- 4. Have some classroom fun and play RESPECT. Instead of saying BINGO, the students say RESPECT. Prizes are up to the teacher (something that may correspond to respect). Teachers: when calling a word, use it in a sentence so students understand how the word is used. Instead of using dots for markers on the RESPECT board have the students collect bottle caps and use them as the markers.
